NON DISCRIMINATION RESOLUTION

(Agenda Item# 6H / Resolution No. 2014-0805-6H)

At the initial meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Charter School of Inquiry (CSI) held on the 5th day of August, 2014, at the Martha Mitchell Community Center, 175 Oakmont, Buffalo, New York, a lawful quorum being present, **the following Resolution was unanimously adopted by the Board of Trustees:**

Pursuant to Article 56 of the Education Law of the State of New York, the Charter School of Inquiry Board of Trustees hereby resolves that Charter School of Inquiry shall not discriminate against any student, employee or other person on the basis of ethnicity, national origin, gender or disability or any other ground that would be unlawful if done by a public school. Admission of students shall not be limited on the basis of intellectual ability, measures of achievement or aptitude, athletic ability, disability, race, creed, gender, national origin, religion or ancestry.

Any child who is qualified under the laws of the State of New York for admission to a public school is qualified for admission to the Charter School of Inquiry.

The Charter School of Inquiry admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges and programs and activities generally and made available to students at the school.

The Charter School of Inquiry is an equal opportunity employer and will hire the most qualified personnel without regard to sex, race, religion, color, creed, national prigin, citizenship, sexual orientation, veteran status, age, martital status or disability. CSI ensures equal treatment in all areas of personnel management, including hiring, promotion, training, layoff or termination.
