

COVID-19 Surveillance and Proximal Testing of Students in Schools

In order for the Erie County Department of Health to conduct COVID-19 testing of students in school, parents/guardians must give permission. Please follow the link below to give the County your consent to test your child with a cheek-swab test (not a nasal test). Tests will be conducted to monitor cases of COVID-19 in schools and to test students if someone in their classroom tested positive for COVID-19. This is an important step in helping schools and the County Department of Health reduce the spread of COVID-19 in schools.

You will need to enter your insurance information in Step 4, but the testing is free to families who are registered.
